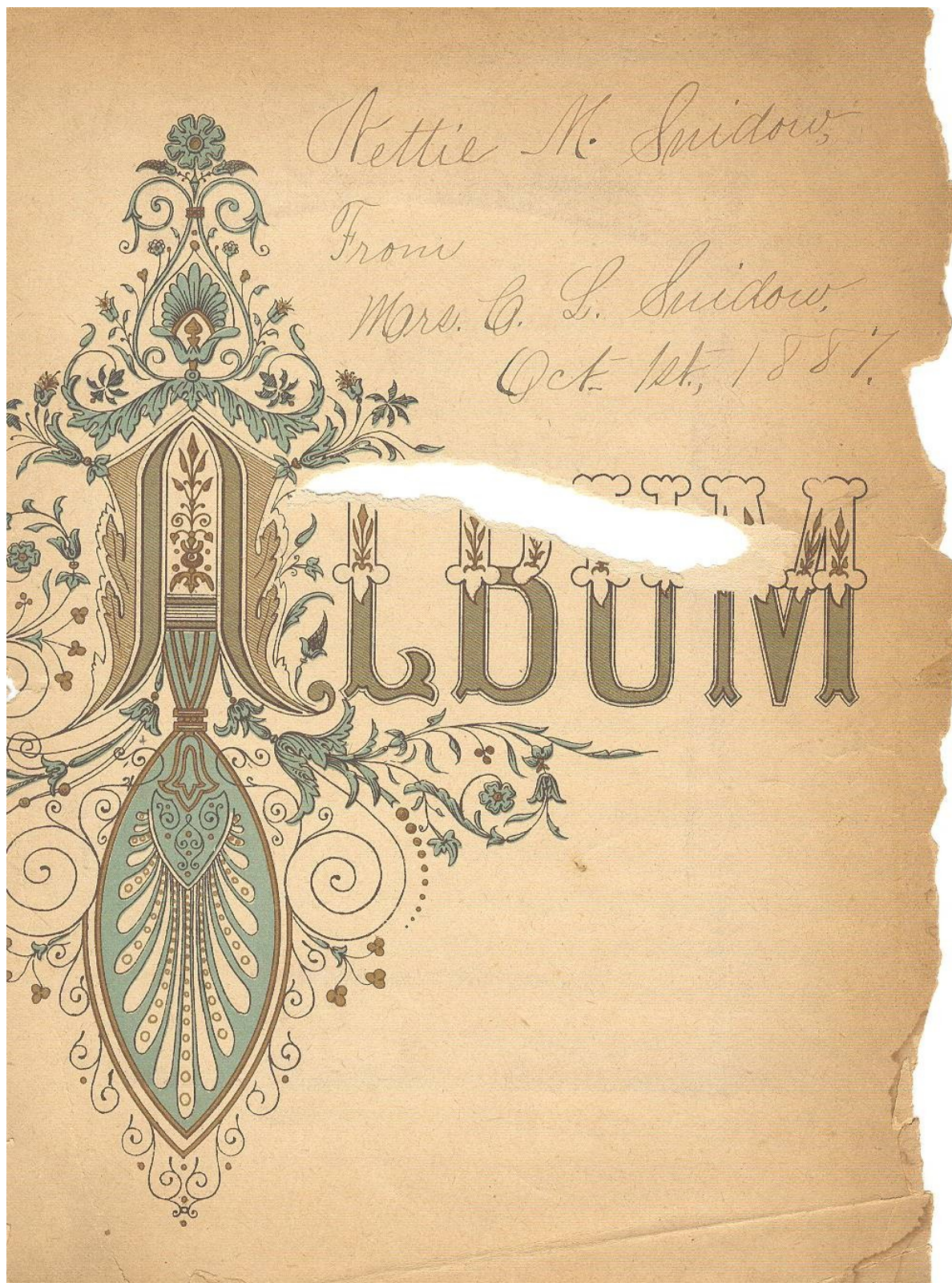


For descendants of **James Harvey Snidow** (1819-1896 - a grandson of Col. Christian Snidow)

Thanks to Jan Tynan of Chicago, IL who very kindly mailed me this old Snidow photo album. Her husband Robert Tynan was a great-grandson of James Harvey Snidow. The 1887 note on the front of this album was from C. L. Snidow 1855-1937 to his sister Nettie (Margaret Manetta Snidow 1860-1923), two of the eight children of James Harvey Snidow. See their genealogy at the end of the photos. C. L. Snidow married Flora Olivia Josephine Harris in VA, moved to MO between 1883 and 1885, then to Falls City, NE. After 1889 he moved to Porter, WA where he died in 1937. Nettie never married. She is buried in Falls City, NE.

On the back of this photo is the printed name of Jewell & Poff, Christiansburg, VA

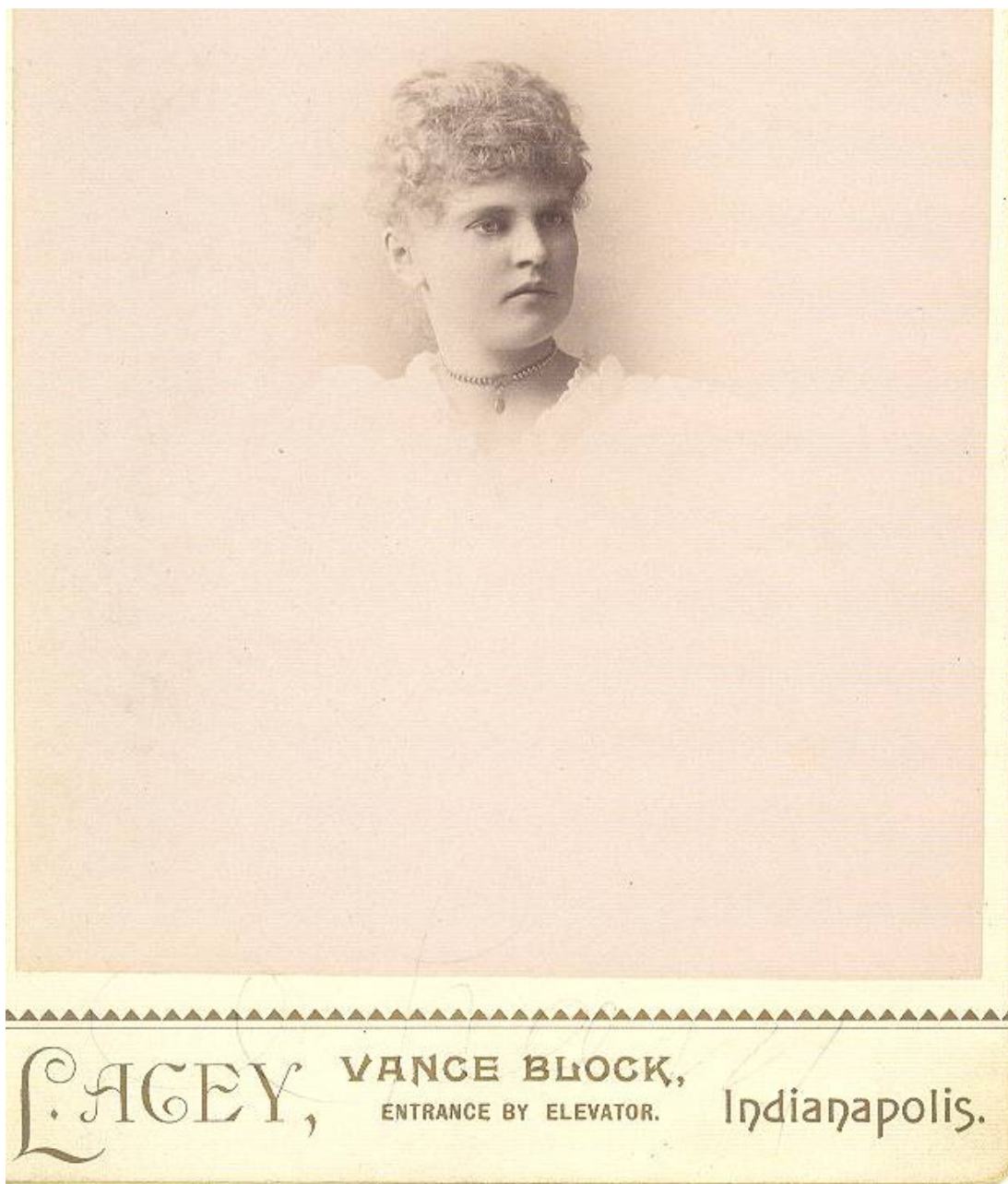
Could this photo be of James Harvey Snidow and his wife Elvina Chapman Lucas Snidow?

The four people in this picture look to be in their twenties. So the timing seems to fit. James & Elvina's daughters are listed below:

The soul is safe in Heaven.



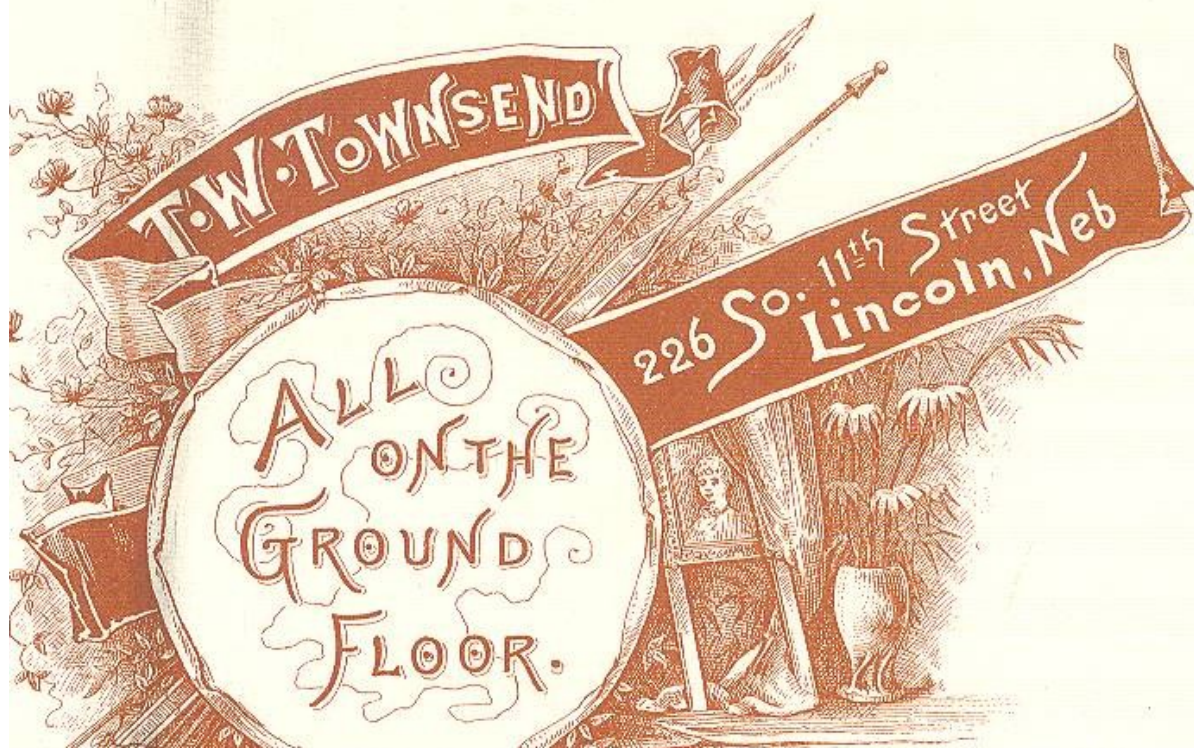

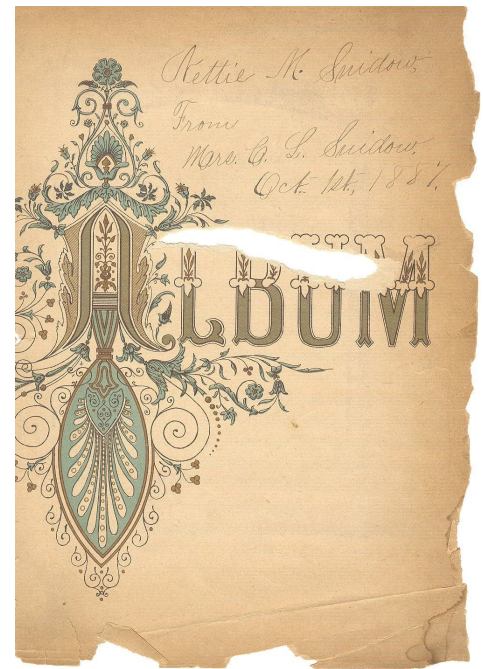




This 126 year old photo album came to us from Mrs. Jan Tynan of Chicago, the widow of a descendant of James Harvey Snidow & Elvina Chapman Lucas Snidow.

The note on the front of this photo album refers to Christian Lee Snidow & Margaret Manetta "Nettie" Snidow, children of James Harvey Snidow. Some of the pictures in this album *may* be of James Harvey Snidow and his wife, children & grandchildren.

Descendants of James Harvey Snidow & Elvina Chapman Lucas

1. Christian 1760-1836 & Mary Burk Snidow. They are buried at Horseshoe Cemetery in Pembroke, VA.
2. John Snidow 1785-1834 m. in 1805 to Rachael Chapman 1785-1863. They are buried at the Snidow-Peck cemetery just off Rt. 635 on VA Lime Co. property near site of the old Hatfield Fort, Pembroke VA.
3. **James Harvey Snidow** (a carpenter), 1819-1886 m. Elvina Chapman Lucas Snidow 1830-1884. Issue - 8 children: *(James was a Sergeant, Co. F, 86th Militia, Breckenridge Div. in the Civil War. Fought at the Battle of New Market. Ref: Virginia Archives, Vol. 20, p. 155.)*
 4. John David Snidow - 1847-1927, sheriff of Giles Co. VA 1895-1907, m. In 1876 to Cynthia Jane Bane b. 1853.
 5. William Bane Snidow b. 1877, m. 1905 to Sadie Patton Slaughter b. 1878.
 6. William Bane Snidow Jr. b. 1906.
 6. Eugenia Tilghman Snidow "Phoebe" b. 1907.
 6. John Temple Snidow b. 1909 m. Margaret Witten.
 7. Margaret Temple Snidow.
 7. William Witten Snidow.
 6. Carroll Snidow 1916-2005 m. Samuel Adams Martin. Issue: 1 child:
 7. Nancy Martin Rader.
 5. Jas. Harvey Snidow 1880-1902, d. unmarried.
 5. Jane Bane Snidow b. 1884, m. G. W. O'Keeffe, Issue: 4 children.
 5. John Harvey Angel 1897-1926.
4. William Lewis Snidow - married twice, lived in several states, died in Oregon.
4. Cornelia Ann Snidow - b. 1853, m. Eugene Boram Angel as his 2nd wife, d. in Oxford, NC. Issue: 4 children.
4. Christian Lee Snidow - 1855-1937. Married in VA to Flora Olivia Josephine Harris, moved to MO btwn 1883-1885 then to Falls City, NE, then after 1889 to Porter, Washington where he died in 1937.
4. Charles Tiffany Snidow, d. in Falls City, NE, previously resided in MO. Married in Kimbalton, VA (near Pearisburg)
4. Margaret Manetta Snidow - 1860-1923. Unmarried, buried in Falls City, NE.
4. Laura Virginia Snidow - living in Falls City, NE in 1945.
4. Mary Sue Chapman Snidow b. 1869, m. 1895 to Lawrence R. Wheeler of Falls City, NE. Known issue-2 children:

 5. Helen Chapman Wheeler b. 5/29/1902; m. 11/28/1939 to Robert Tynan. Known issue - 1 child:
