The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bound Jacob Snidow hath this day obtained License for his marriage with Clara Burk Daughter of Thomas Burk of this County now if there should be no just Cause to obstruct the s.<sup>d</sup> marriage then the above Obligation to be void or else to remain in full force & Virtue

our Seals and dated this 6<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1793

the above bound Jacob Snidow hath this Day obtained a licence  
for his Marriage with Sally Pickelheimer Daughter of Jacob  
Pickelheimer now if there should be no Legal Cause to Obstruct the said  
Marriage then the above Obligation to be void Else to remain in full

presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this *12th* day of *February*  
1798

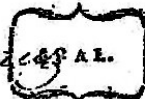
**T**HE condition of this obligation is such, that whereas the above bound
