Other notes:

According to the *Giles Co. VA History - Families Vol. I , page 179,* James E. "O'Brien" is buried in the Williams Cemetery which is on a hill behind the old Pembroke school. (Elizabeth, their daughter, married Harper Williams.) Their house was located right next to the Pembroke school and below the hill on which the Williams Cemetery is located.

James & Mattie lived in a house on the farm of Mattie's parents, William Luther and Mary Stiff Snidow*. Their farm is now the Castle Rock Golf Course in Pembroke, VA. The house sat on the edge of the hill above New River and upon the hill and just around the curve from the George Snidow homeplace.
